

WOMEN'S PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

Introduced in 1932, the first winners, Mesdames Roberts and Craxford, hailed from Middlesex. In 2002, Herefordshire sisters Linda Smith and Tracey Powell became the first women to win a national title wearing trousers. The title has been won four times by Cambridgeshire's remarkable mother-&-daughter duo Sue Alexander and Ellen Falkner. The reigning (2019) champions are Lincolnshire's Sheila Plaskitt & Penny Strong.
