

MEN'S TWO-BOWL SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP

Women bowlers have been enjoying the 21-end two-wood singles game since 1939, but the demanding discipline was not introduced for men until 2012, when Tristan Morton (Huntingdonshire) was the first winner. The winners in the first eight years have all come from different counties. They have included international stars Sam Tolchard (Devon) and Jamie Walker (Northamptonshire), but Herefordshire's Shaun Jones is the reigning (2019) champion.
