Best Practice: The club should have a section for safeguarding available on the front loading page in a prominent position. The club safeguarding contacts should be clear and easy to find in this section.	
Are there safeguarding pages on the club website?	
Best Practice: The club should have a section for safeguarding available on the front loading page in a prominent position.	
Does the club link to the Bowls England approved safeguarding policy for Children on their website?	
Best Practice: The club should have a section for safeguarding available on the front loading page in a prominent position, under this there should be a link to this page	
Does the club link to the Bowls England approved safeguarding policy for Adults on their website?	
Best Practice: The club should have a section for safeguarding available on the front loading page in a prominent position, under this there should be a link to this page	
Does the website include what to do in the event of a concern or disclosure?	
Best Practice: The club should have details for the club safeguarding officer and the NGB Lead Safeguarding officer, it might be useful to include a link to $\underline{\text{this}}$ document.	
Does the website include a copy of the clubs code of conduct?	
Best Practice: This should be for club members, coaches, officials, volunteers, parents, carers, spectators etc. This should include; Anti-Bullying, Social Media Policy, Photography Policy	



Does the website provide links to the Bowls England Safeguarding pages?

Best Practice: This should include in all safeguarding advice, so all club members have access.
